Part of the role of the School is to inspire self-respect in the students so that they stand as an example to others. A uniform helps this in a number of ways. It fosters unity within the school to which each child can happily and clearly belong and also present this unity to the world. Care for the uniform and pride in the principles for which it stands are also valuable lessons for children.

There are many opportunities within the School for the children to exhibit and expand those elements of their being which are special to themselves – the wearing of school uniform is not one of them.

1. Full school uniform appropriate to the season as set out in the Uniform List must be worn to, from and at School and, again where appropriate, on out of school excursions. This includes rules for hair;
2. The uniform must be clean, neat, tidy and in good repair and clearly labelled with the child's name;
3. In the event that full school uniform is not worn then a note, phone call or other direct communication from the parent/s is required. In light of this communication a reasonable period may be allowed for the appropriate items of uniform to be obtained;
4. For children in Infants grades (Lower 1st, Upper 1st and 2nd class) a high standard of uniform is still being inculcated. Every encouragement from both parents and teachers will be given in this area;
5. In the event that full school uniform is not worn by a Primary child (3rd to 6th class) and there is no direct communication from the parent/s then the child may receive a recess detention;
6. Further infractions may attract increased penalties;
7. Persistent refusal to wear full school uniform may result in suspension from classes;
8. The document entitled "Uniform List" as amended from time to time forms part of the Uniform Policy. Hair regulations are included in the Uniform List. The Uniform List may be obtained from the School Office.
